As you consider recruiting new residents/fellows for the coming or following academic year, please keep in mind that applications for candidates who are IMGs or requesting visa sponsorship, are subject to additional review.

All applicants to ACGME-accredited training programs must be eligible for licensure in the State of CA in accordance with the Medical Board or Osteopathic Medical Board of California and must apply for the appropriate license within six months of the deadline by which they are required to obtain either a Post-Graduate Training or Full Physician & Surgeon's license.

Please submit the documents listed below for GME review. DIO approval is required prior to ranking, matches, job offers or other commitments to candidates requesting visa sponsorship or who have graduated from a foreign medical school.
