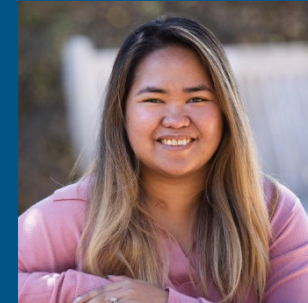

- The guidelines are very strict



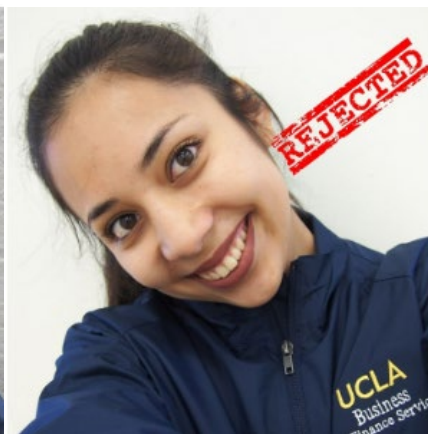
### To Note

Think Passport Quality Photo:

- Solid White Background
- Looking straight into camera
- Only you in the photo
- No accessories in photo (eyeglasses ok)
- High Resolution

They only accept .jpeg

- Do Not upload from your iPhone. .HEIC is not accepted

## Step 5 – Medical Clearance Form & Covid Vaccinations

### Medical Clearance Forms - UCLA Health Shadowing

#### What it asks

- **Immunity to Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella** – UCLA Health Mandatory
- **Evidence of COVID Vaccine(s)** – UCLA Health Mandatory
- **Tuberculosis Testing** – UCLA Health Mandatory
- **Tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis Vaccine (Tdap)** – Can Decline
- **Hepatitis B Vaccination** – Can Decline
- **Flu Vaccine** – UCLA Health Mandatory
- **Signature from Licensed Healthcare Provider** – UCLA Health Mandatory

## Arrival

### **Sunday, July 23, 2023**

- Plan to arrive by Noon
- Room Check-in will be 2-3:30pm
- Mandatory Welcome Meeting and Tour will start at 3:30pm

# Information for Air Travelers



The drive from the airport to UCLA can take anywhere between 20-40 minutes depending on traffic conditions, therefore, **we recommend booking flights that arrive anytime by Noon on Sunday, July 23, 2023.**

Remember that check-in will take place from **2pm-3:30pm at UCLA.**

We do not provide a shuttle directly from the airport; however, the options below can get you to the check-in location fairly easily.

## Getting to UCLA

Option 1: Rideshare. Cost varies from \$30 - \$60

Option 2: Super Shuttle. Cost varies from \$50 - \$80

Option 3: Public Transportation. Cost about \$1.25

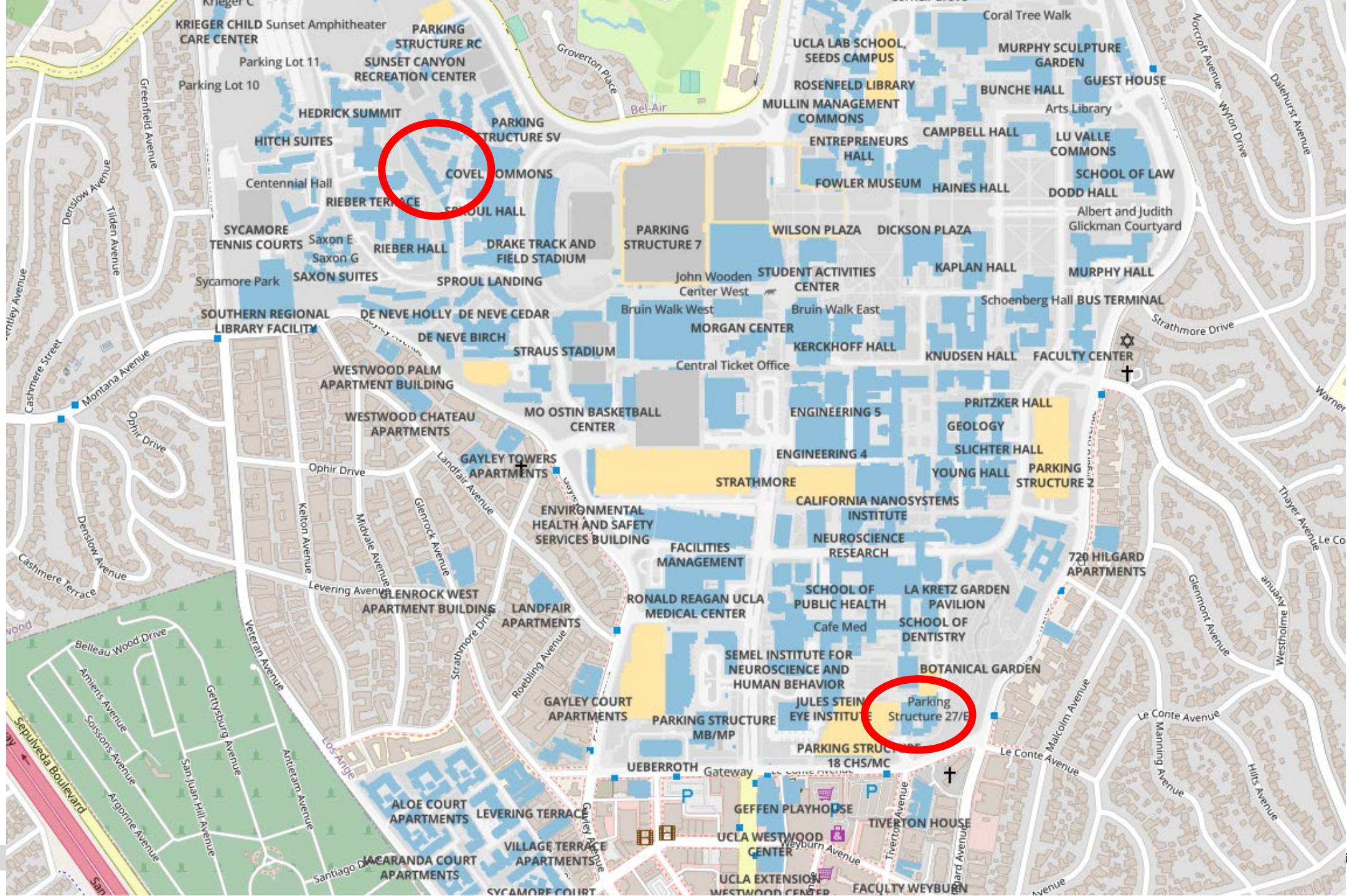
# General Dorm Layout
