2111. An appointment pursuant to Section 2111 must be renewed annually and may not exceed a total of three years.

2113. A Certificate of Registration pursuant to Section 2113 must be renewed annually, and may be renewed routinely for a period of two years from the date of the issuance of the original certificate. Upon request by the dean of a medical school, the Medical Board of California may exercise its discretion in deciding whether to renew a Certificate of Registration beyond the third year. The dean must substantiate the registrant's progress towards medical licensure and provide appropriate documentation confirming the registrant's receipt of a certificate issued by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates.
